- 294 **ALCHON HUNS. Khingila, ca. 440-490 AD.** Silver Drachm. 3.49 gm. Tall bust w/ conical cap and earring r., Brahma legend before, tamgha behind / Crude fire-altar w/ attendants, vague Ahura Mazda head r. in flames (imitating the Sassanian issue of Shapur III). *This is likely an early issue for the Gandhara region.* Göbl *Hunnen* Em 57.3. *Somewhat grainy. Crude* **VF** **200.**
- 295 **Raja Lakhana-Udayaditya (Khingila), ca. 430-490 AD.** Silver Drachm. *Indian issue, struck ca. 470-480 AD.* 3.73 gm. Tall bust r. wearing a conical crown w/ crescent, and earring; Brahma legend before and behind / Crude fire-altar w/ attendants. Göbl *Hunnen* 79.2. **RARE** **VF** **300.**
- 296 **ALCHON-CHIONITE HUNS. Ca. Fifth Century AD.** Silver Drachm. 3.64 gm. Peroz-type bust r. / Fire altar with stylized attendants, AlChoNo in the right margin. C/m in obverse margin (Göbl # 93). MACW 1458. *Toned* **VF** **125.**
- 297 **NEZAK HUNS, in Kapisa-Kabul. Anonymous. Ca. 515-560 AD.** Billon Reduced Drachma. 21mm. 2.59 gm. Bust r. wearing 'spiny-top' crown, tamgha behind / Crude fire altar with attendants. Göbl *Hunnen* EM 203/2. **RARE. Deep gray over light deposits** **VF** **125.**

- 298 **Anonymous. Ca. 515-560 AD.** AE Reduced Drachma. 20mm. 2.07 gm. 'Napki Malik'-style bust r. with bull's head crown / Fire altar flanked by tamghas on pedestals and stars above. Göbl *Hunnen* Em.228var. **RARE** **About VF** **125.**
- 299 **Shahi Tigin. Ca. 710-720 AD.** Billon Drachm. 3.29 gm. Crowned bust r. / Fire altar with large crude attendants. MACW 1554. *Dark gray over light deposits* **About EF** **150.**
- 300 **Sanogolo-Bagdaiggo. Time of Shahi Tigin, ca. 720 AD.** AE 24x21. 1.19 gm. Crude foreparts of two winged lions facing each other, solar symbol above, legend below / Tamgha in circle, legend around. Göbl *Hunnen* Em.245, Alram 1484, MACW 1497. **RARE. Crinkly upper reverse** **F / VG** **100.**
- 301 **KHWAREZM. King Ramik . Mid-Sixth Century AD.** AR Drachm. 6.51 gm. King's head r. wearing an elaborate crown / Horseman; Khwarezmian legend around: *MR'Y MLK rmyk* – "King of Kings Ramik." Biriukov p.29, 43, Wainberg Г/1. **RARE. Toned.** **About VF** **400.**
