Within beaded circle: Abaqa's Uyghur protocol in five lines: Qaghanu/nereber/Abagha-yin/deletkeguluksen, the last word ending on the fifth line ("of the Khaqan, in the name of, by Abagha, struck") / Within circle: Kalima in Arabic, ending Salah Allah 'alaiya wa salem. A-2126.2. RARE. Weakness at centers and typical flatness in margins About EF

GOLD Dinar, madinat Tabriz, d.o.f. 5.84 gm. Abaqa's Uyghur protocol arranged differently and in four lines, with Abagha-yin on the second, uncertain Mongol word on fourth line, star above legend / Kalima as above. A-2126.2. RARE. About 15% flat right obverse margin
