GREAT MONGOLS (Chinghizids). Time of Mongke, AH 649-658/1251-1260. GOLD Dinar, Khodzend (ca. AH 657-8). 4.52 gm. Prophetic statement followed by mint (partial, but clear) / Khani, al-Imam al-'Azam al-Nasir al-(Din Allah). About 35% flat. Unpublished and EXTREMELY RARE

GOLD Dinar, Khodzend (ca. AH 657-8). 3.7 gm. Mintname above Prophetic statement / Khani al-Imam al-'Azam al-Nasir al-Din Allah Khodzend. Edge cracked on right side, missing about 15%. Still clear mint and legible legends. Unpublished and EXTREMELY RARE. Crude About VF

Mongke, AH 649-658/1251-1260. GOLD Dinar (Herat, ca. AH 657-8). 3.36 gm. Munggu Qa(`an) al-`Adl / Prophetic 403 statement. Small snippets of uncertain legend in margin. EXTREMELY RARE. Some flatness at centers. Crude

ILKHANID (Mongols of Persia). Abaqa, AH 665-680/1265-1282. GOLD Dinar, Yazd d.o.f. 4.04 gm. Arabic legends only. Qa'an badshah 'Alim Ilkhan al-'Azam Abaqa. Cf.SNAT 1662, A.2126.1. RARE. Minor flatness in margins, only parts of mint letters visible

GOLD Dinar, (Tabriz) AH 679. 3.75 gm. Within beaded circle: Abaqa's Uyghur protocol in five lines: Qaghanu/nereber/Abagha-yin/deletkeguluksen, the last word ending on the fifth line ("of the Khaqan, in the name of, by Abagha, struck") / Within circle: Kalima in Arabic, ending Salah Allah 'alaiya wa salem. A-2126.2. RARE. Weakness at centers and typical flatness in margins About EF

GOLD Dinar, madinat Tabriz, d.o.f. 5.84 gm. Abaqa's Uyghur protocol arranged differently and in four lines, with Abagha-yin on the second, uncertain Mongol word on fourth line, star above legend / Kalima as above. A-2126.2. RARE. About 15% flat right obverse margin

- 407 Arghun, AH 683-690/1284-1291. GOLD Dinar, (Tabriz) AH 68x. 4.02 gm. Arghun's Uyghur protocol, with his name repeated in Arabic at end / Within circle: Kalima in Arabic, ending Salah Allah `alaiya wa salem. A-2144. Scarce. Two minor edge splits, and typical flatness in peripheries

- **408** GOLD Dinar, *Tabriz* AH 685. 4.46 gm. Types as above. A few small edge splits. Some typical flatness in margins **EF 300.**

- 409 GOLD Dinar, madinat Tabriz, AH 690. 4.39 gm. Types as last. A-2144. Scarce Good VF 250.
- 410 Gaykhatu (as Irenjin Turji), AH 690-694/1291-1295. GOLD Dinar, *Tabriz*, d.o.f. 4.35 gm. The Ilkhan's Uyghur protocol / Within circle: Kalima in Arabic, ending *Salah Allah `alaiya wa salem*. Mint on both sides. *Very light deposits*. *Typical flat areas in margin*About EF
- 411 GOLD Dinar, mint and d.o.f. 4.15 gm. Types similar to last, but Salah Allah 'alaiya [wa salem] around, fancy knot at bottom. Irregular edge VF 200.



- 412 GOLD Dinar, mint and date off flan. 5.1 gm. The Ilkhan's Uyghur protocol, *Irenjin Turji* below in Arabic/ The Kalima within a quadrilobe, *Allah* in first line between two crescents, arabesque knot below. *Scarce type*Good VF

- 413 Ghazan Mahmud, AH 694-703/1295-1304. Pre-reform Coinage. GOLD Dinar, mint and date off flan (types of Tabriz). 4.72 gm. Protocol in Arabic script: Badshah Islam Shahinshah Ghazan Khan khalid [Allah] mulkahu, star above ghayn of Ghazan / Within circle: Kalima ending Salah Allah `alaiya wa salem. A-2167. VERY RARE. Typical flatness in margins, minor filing on reverse edge

- 414 GOLD Dinar, *Tabriz* d.o.f. 5.12 gm. Types similar to above, but protocol beginning *badshah Islam* is within a circle, legend around, and *Salah Allah `alaiya wa salem* is arranged around the kalima. *VERY RARE. Margins mostly flat*Good VF

- 415 GOLD Dinar, Tabriz, AH 693. 5.0 gm. Muled with the reverse (kalima side) of an earlier Dinar of Gaykhatu, hence the date 693. The obverse protocol in Arabic script reads: Badshah jehan al-Sultan al-`Azam Qazan Mahmud khalid [Allah] mulkahu, trilobes and fleurets in field. Cf.A-2167. VERY RARE. An interesting piece both for the muling and the misspelling of Ghazan as Qazan. 15-20% flat on obv. left
- 416 GOLD Dinar, *Tabriz* d.o.f. 4.22 gm. Types similar to above, but *zarb Tabriz* at end of protocol and fancy ornament above *badshah jehan. VERY RARE. Minor flatness in margins*EF
