Coronation type. âmadeh az Fath-i `Ali sekke be-zar-e shahi in three lines / Fancy lozenge formed from a ornate quadrilobe and a square containing the mint, its epithet and date. Cf.A-2860. VERY RARE. Very minor weakness About EF
- GOLD ½ Toman, Dar al-Saltana Tehran AH 1212. 3.11 gm. Coronation type. âmadeh az Fath-i 'Ali sekke be-zar-e 418 shahi in three lines / fancy tablet formed from a square and a ornate quadrilobe. The mint and its epithet in the square, the date in the lower leaved panel, al-Mulk Allah in the top leaved panel. Cf.A-2860. VERY RARE. Minor flatness bottom obverse Good VF



- GANJA KHANATE. Muhammad Hasan Khan, AH 1174-1195/1760-1780. Abbasi, Ganja AH 1189. Ya sahib oz-419 zamân in central cartouche / Mint and date in central cartouche. A-2944. RARE. Some staining in margins VF
- Ja`far al-Jawaad (?), ca. AH 1200-1220/1785-1805. Abbasi, Ganja AH 12(1?)6. Kalima in circle, outer border of 420 beads / Zarb ya Karim Ganja in central medallion, outer border of large beads. Rayij c/m on obverse. A- (Cf.A-2943 for similar type dated AH 1174-1177, and 1189). VERY RARE and apparently unpublished VF

- KHIVA KHANATE. Muhammad Amin Khan, AH 1261-1271/1845-1855. GOLD ½ Tilla, Khwarezm AH 1261. 422 2.23 gm. Dated both sides. Ruler's protocol in teardrop with ornate border / Mint and date in ornately bordered circle. A-3082, Cr.65. VERY RARE. Minor weakness in peripheries About EF
