**Leopold, 1657-1705.** GOLD 5 Ducat, 1703 NB. *Nagybanya*. 16.54 gm. Laureate, draped and cuirassed bust r., Hungarian shield and Madonna and Child in legend / Crowned Imperial eagle with Arms on breast. *A few apparent prong marks on edge indicate jewelry usage -- typical for this large gold coinage, for nearly all of them were mounted in some fashion for wearing or presentation
