

RUSSO-JAPANESE WAR, 1904-1905



- 722 Award Medal for the Battle of Chemulpo.** 1904. Silver. 30 mm. St. George Cross surrounded by laurel wreath and legend / Naval engagement with Russian battleship "Varyag" and "Koreez," cross above, Japanese fleet behind. Chep 950, V 245, W fig 120. **EXCESSIVELY RARE** and important. The rarest medal of this last part of the collection. On original ribbon -- a great rarity in itself **EF** **5,000.**



- 723 Award Medal for Medical and Red Cross Personnel in the Russo-Japanese War.** Silver. 24 mm. Hallmarked on loop. Cross in red enamel / Three-line legend. Chep 955, V 249. On a bar with ribbon **EF** **125.**
