Maurice Tiberius, 582-602. Æ Pentanummia (= Follis). Cherson mint. Maurice, on l., and the Empress Constantia on r., surrounded by legend / Large H; Theodosius nimbate, stg facing. SB 607; DO 303. Scarce. Very nice green patina. VF to Ch VF. 3 pieces





Alexius I,1081-1118 .AR Aspron Trachy.Pre-reform coinage of 1081-1092.3.79 gm.Thessalonika.Nimbate Christ enthroned facing,holding Gospels /Nimbate St.Demetrios standing at left,in military attire and holding sword, presents patriarchal cross to Alexius at right,wearing crown and loros.DOC IV pt.1,5a.1;SB 1905.Scarce .Some roughness. Good VF

Georgia. AR 'Kirmaneuli'. Georgian imitation of Trebizond Asper of John II. Ca. Late 13th - early 14th Cent. John II, stg. facing, wearing crown, tunic and mantle, holding labarum and globus, with a long cross / St. Eugenius, bearded and nimbate, stg. facing with cross in l. hand. Inscription on both sides is distorted. Cf.Lang 52. Scarce Choice VF
