Dav.8904. *A Rare and interesting coin from what was Charlemagne's capital. Minor weakness in margins and on last two digits of date.*

SAXE-WEIMAR. Eight Brothers, 1605-1619. ½ Taler, 1611. Four half-figures facing obv. and rev. *Slight d/s. Toned About EF*

SAXONY. August I, 1553-1586. Taler, 1584. Armored half-figure r. holding sword, dividing date / Tri-helmeted Arms. Dav.9798. *Light graffiti lower part of half-figure and left reverse helmet. Toned VF+*

Johann Georg II, 1656-1680. 1/3 Taler, 1673 CR. Dresden. Bewigged, armored bust r. / Crowned, garnished Arms, C-R, value in oval below. Kohl 231. **Good VF**
