Khwarezm. King awshafan. Drachm. Type 2. Shoulder portrait of a king in elaborate crown right / horseman right with a tamgha behind and Khwarezmian legend *MR'Y MLK rmyk* (King of Kings Ramik) around. Biriukov p. 30, 80; Vainberg Г/ I. **VERY RARE. Good F**

King Tarnavch. Late 7th - Early 8th Cent. Bronze 21mm. 2.41 gm. Galloping beast right / tamgha surrounded by Sogdian inscription *xwâw trnâ*. Rtvel 54; Smirnova 1499 ff; Rtveladze. Pre-Muslim Coins of Chach. - *Silk Road Art and Archaeology V* (1997/98), p. 316. **RARE. Almost EF**

Chach. Unknown ruler, Ca. 3rd-4th Cent. AD. Bronze. 11-19 mm. Diad. Hd. l., head tied and falling in wavy strands / Tamgha, Sogdian legend around. Rtvel 40. Twenty five (25) pieces



SASANIAN. Shapur I, 241-272. Hemidrachm. Types similar to above. Gobl I/I, 24. RARE. Good VF



UMAYYAD. In the time of al-Walid II-Ibrahim, AH 125-127/743-744 AD. AE Fals, al-Kufa AH 126. Within double circle framed by four annulets, three line Arabic legend: "Allah ordered honesty and equity," triplet of pellets below. Walker P. 143. VERY RARE Choice VF



Harun al-Rashid, AH 170-193/786-809 AD. North African imitation of Dirham obverse of Madinat al-Salaam AH 164 with standard Yazid reverse. Obverse margin legend omits the word sanat / Letter symbol above, Yazid below. RARE. Typical North African striations obv. and rev. and thin test scratches typical of Russian and Northern European finds. VF

FATIMIDS. Al-Mu`izz, AH 341-365/953-975 AD. ½ Dirham, *al-Mansuriyya* AH 357. Three concentric circles of legends, pellet at center. A-699. **Scarce.** *Full flan. Toned. About EF*



SAFFARIDS. Ahmad b. Muhammad, AH 311-352/923-963 AD. AE Fals, Zaranj AH 329. Ruler cited by his kunya Abu Ja`far. Reverse central legend in beaded circle, with outer margin of annulets. Cf. J. Walker, "The Coinage of the Second Saffarid Dynasty in Sistan," ANSNM 72, 1936. **RARE.** Somewhat rough surfaces. VF



IRAN. Safavids. Sultan Husayn, AH 1105-1135/1694-1722 AD. Rectangular 5 Shahi, Iravan AH 1128. Titles, mint and date /Shi`a Kalima in two lines. A-2677.1. VF



BUKHARA. Muzaffar al-Din, AH 1277-1303/1860-1886 AD. GOLD Tilla, AH 1289. Similar types to above. A-3038, Cr. 95. VF

GOLDEN HORDE. Anonymous, ca. 2nd half of the 13th Century AD. Dirham, nm nd. Anepigraphic. Likely struck at Bulghar on the Volga. Tamgha in circle/Tri-arc at center. **Rare.** *Flat area in margin. Good VF*

Girey Khans. Crimea. Shahin Giray AH 1191. Silver. Yirmilc. Year 4. **VERY RARE**
