**Julius Caesar.** GOLD Aureus, **46 BC.** Moneyer: Aulus Hirtius. Veiled female head (Vesta?) r.; C CAESAR COS TER / Lituus, jug and ax. *Craw.466/1. Fine style. Irregular flan with lip at right. Good VF*

Nero,54-68 AD.GOLD Aureus,60-1 AD.7.59 gm. Bare bust r./ Virtus standing l., foot on pile of arms, holding sword and spear. RIC 25,Cohen 219.*Nice portrait . Almost EF*

**Vespasian, 69-79 AD.** GOLD Aureus, 69-71 AD. Rome. 6.81 gm. Laureate head r.; IMP CAESAR VESPASIANVS AVG / Pax seated l. holding branch; COS. ITER TR.POT. RIC 109. *Graffiti 'N' in reverse field. Two very small edge splits. Almost VF / F*



**Antoninus Pius, 138-161 AD.** GOLD Aureus. Rome. 7.28 gm. Laureate bust r./ Emperor standing l. holding globe and roll; TR POT XIX COS IIII. RIC 256a, Cohen 995. *Superb portrait and reverse type. FDC*

Elagabalus. Aureus. 218/9. Antioch. 7.05 gm. Bust left/ Stone of Emesa on quadriga right. RIC 196A variant. EXTREMELY RARE. About EF

**Julian II, 360-363 AD.** GOLD Solidus, 361-3 AD. *Antioch.* Diademed, draped and cuirassed bust r. / Soldier walking r., looking back, holding trophy and placing other hand on the head of a kneeling captive. RIC 202 (R4). *File scrape on center of diadem. EF*



Arcadius, 383-408 AD. GOLD Solidus, 397-402 AD. Constantinople. Officina D. 4.39 gm. Diad, helmeted and cuirassed bust facing three-quarters r., holding spear / Constantinopolis seated facing r. holding scepter and Victory on globe, CONOB in ex. RIC 7. Somewhat weak at centers. Graffiti in obverse field About EF
